

Top 10 Benefits of blt Tutorials

1. **Fewer distractions.** In a classroom setting, noise and other interruptions from peer groups can hugely affect a learner's performance. This is especially true if a learner suffers from Attention Deficit Disorder. Bespoke tuition, tailored to an individual's needs, provides a more controllable environment in which the learner is far less susceptible to interference.
2. **Choice of tutor.** A **blt** tutor is selected who has a style and personality to suit the learner, and, if it is not working, he or she can be changed at the learner's request.
3. **Focus on specific areas.** A **blt** tutor is able to focus on specific areas that the learner may be having problems with. A school teacher will only be able to give limited attention to learners, as they are constrained by time and tough targets for subject coverage.
4. **Confidence and self-esteem.** These are important variables in the learning process. The more confident a learner feels in their study, the more creative their thought processes become, enabling them to grasp complicated concepts far more effectively.
5. **Enthusiasm.** **blt** provides tutors who have a passion for their subject. This can be infectious for the learner, who may share in our tutor's interest and fascination for their subject.
6. **Catch-up.** Sometimes a learner may have missed key points in a syllabus that are now holding them back from understanding more advanced concepts. A **blt** tutor will quickly identify areas that need work and bring the learner up to speed. This is especially important if the learner has been ill and missed several lessons.
7. **Shy learners can ask questions.** Many learners may be too shy to ask questions in a classroom environment and may then miss out on key points in the subject matter. Such learners are more likely to ask questions in a one-on-one or small group environment.
8. **Coverage.** A **blt** tutor is able to cover a lot of detail in a short time. They can work at the learner's pace and become familiar with the learner's capacity for learning and the methods that work best for that learner. Every learner is different

and **blt** tutors are trained to identify and adapt to the individual needs and capabilities of each learner.

9. **Help with homework.** If a learner is struggling with homework, a **blt** tutor can help. They can provide the answers a learner needs and the tools they can use to find the answers for themselves.

10. **Handling attention span.** A learner may only be able to concentrate for 10 minutes before their mind starts to wander onto other things.
